

Medication guidance in connection with surgery

Your child is having tubes in the eardrum

This procedure does NOT require painkillers

Your child is having adenoids removed

1-2 hours before surgery, painkiller Panodil suppository or oral is given. The dose is 40 mg/kg, which is higher than indicated in the package insert.

After surgery often painkillers are needed in the next few days, Panodil is recommended after 4 hours as you usually give it and according to weight
It is expected to be needed for no more than 2-3 days

Your child is having tonsils partially removed

2 hours before surgery painkiller Panodil suppository or oral is given. The dose is 40 mg/kg, which is higher than indicated in the package insert.

After surgery painkillers will be needed.

After 4 hours Panodil can be given again and according to the usual dos/kg. It must be supplemented with Bonyl mixture, for which you will receive a prescription, and must be picked up at a pharmacy. It is by weight and the dose is indicated on the medicine when you pick it up. It is expected that painkillers will be needed for 3-4 days, if longer you must contact the clinic.

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
